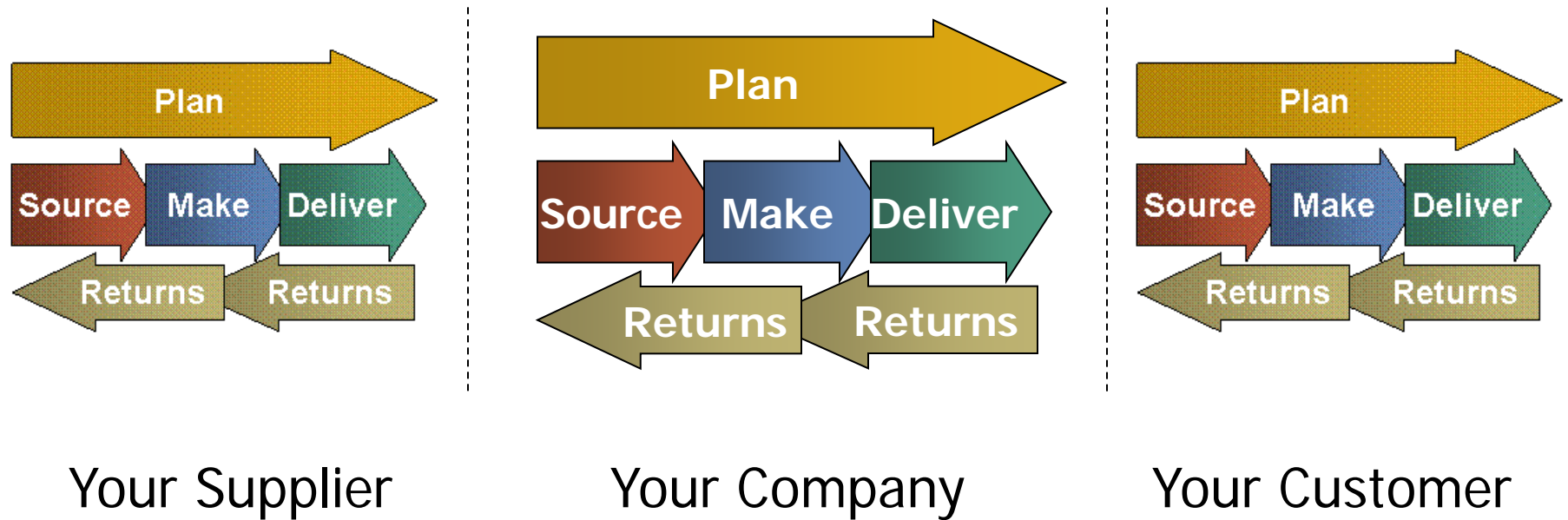

Supply Chain Management Course Summary

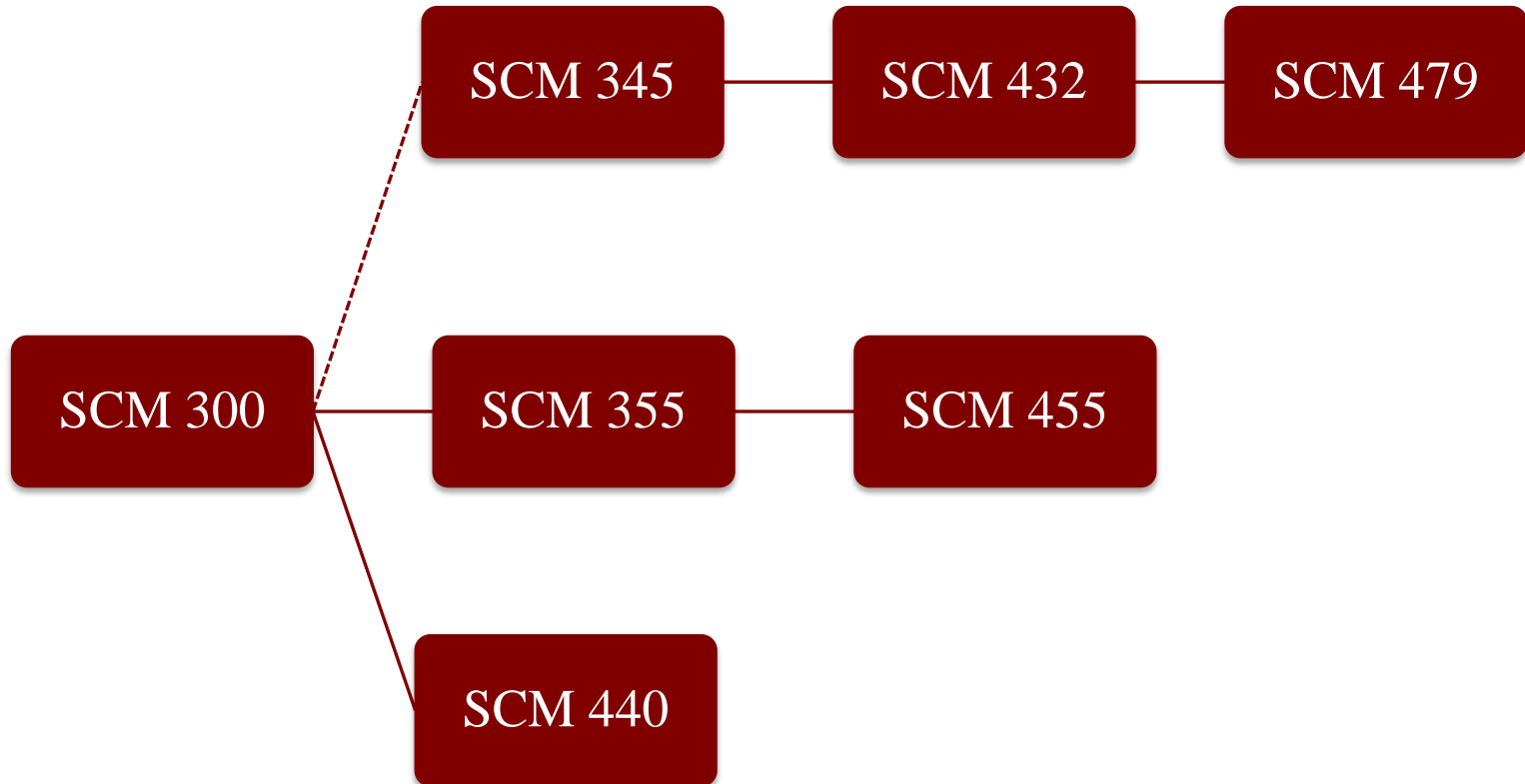
9 total courses
